- Udongo na utunzaji wa maji ikiwa ni pamoja na utengenezaji wa mboji na ‘ubunifu wa swale’
- Teknolojia sahihi kama vile majiko ya roketi na njia za usafi wa mazingira
- Ufumbuzi wa njia za kupata kipato kama asali, uyoga na ufugaji wa samaki
- Utangulizi katika lishe bora na dawa za asili
