What:	This is an intensive interactive course that covers all the topics in the Internationally Recognised 72hour PDC. It will be officially accredited by the Permaculture Research Institute of Australia (PRI).

Course Fee:	US\$ 850 (or \$600for local participants and for interns) [a 10% early bird discount is available if you pay by 15 th February 2013]				
You will gain:	 A PDC certificate accredited by Strawberry Fields Eco Lodge and the PRI. A well grounded understanding of Permaculture ethics and principals, and their application in a range of environments. Learn about and experience the fascinating culture on the Konso people. Make contact with like-minded group of people from around the world. 				
Included:	 Catering for the duration of the course (3 meals and 2 snacks) Camping (we have some tents that can be used in needed but best to bring your own). The PDC training Certificates Basic stationary items can be provided, but bring your own also. 				
Not included:	Although the following items are not included in the course fee we can offer you advice on these issues if you require so don't hesitate to ask: Travel to/from Ethiopia Internal travel within Ethiopia Medical expenses Travel insurance Stationary and other personal equipment Accommodation in Addis Ababa Accommodation upgrades are available at the following price scale for the 13 day PDC: Dorm \$20 Single \$200 Double \$300				

TRAVEL ARANGEMENTS:

Arrival and onward travel:	Participants should ideally arrive in Addis Ababa 3 days before the course starts, unless they are planning to fly down to the south on a domestic flight. It is possible to fly down to Arbaminch on Sundays, so if you want to do this you should fly down on the Sunday the day before the start of the course (we always begin our courses on a Monday). This will mean you can avoid the LONG 12-14 hour car journey the whole way down to Konso. You will then go on to Konso by minibus the same day OR we can send our car to collect you on the Sunday (note that there will be a charge of \$80 for collection from Arbaminch, which can be split between the group). The same journey can be done by bus which is cheap but not comfortable. If you are making your own way to Konso by any other means, you should be there by the day before the start of the course at the latest. We have 4 (or 5) spaces in our car and can bring you down from Addis by vehicle if there is enough demand (Note it will cost \$300 each way per group, which you can split between a group, so may be a little cheaper than the plane depending on the price fluctuations – check with Ethiopian Airlines). If you do decide to travel down by car, the car will leave for Konso from Addis on the Saturday so that they group can rest up on the Sunday. Please let us know <i>in good time</i> which options you prefer for internal transport so that we can make arrangements on your behalf.
